## BOMUSD Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten

The Kindergarten program for Black Oak Mine includes both a one year program and a two-year program. The one year Kindergarten is for those students who turn five by Sept. 1 and who are developmentally ready for a traditional Kindergarten (K) program. The two-year Kindergarten is one year of Transitional Kindergarten (TK) and a second year in traditional Kindergarten. The TK class is designed to serve students who turn five between the dates of Sept. 2 and March 15th or for those who are not quite ready for traditional Kindergarten based upon developmental assessments and parent choice (dependent on enrollment). All students begin school in August.
